Alan P. Nelson is the Chief - Emergency Preparedness in the Nuclear Generation Division of the Nuclear Energy Institute (NEI) located in Washington, DC.

NEI is the organization of the commercial nuclear power industry that is responsible for coordinating the combined efforts of all nuclear utilities and other nuclear industry organizations in all matters involving generic operational and technical regulatory issues. NEI serves as the industry's principal mechanism for conveying industry's views, concerns, and policies to the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission and other government agencies as appropriate. Mr. Nelson is responsible for all issues relating to emergency planning.

Mr. Nelson graduated magna cum laude from Manhattan College with a B.S. degree in radiological and health sciences. He is a guest lecturer at the Harvard School of Public Health and recognized in Who's Who in Science and Engineering.

Mr. Nelson has been with NEI since 1988 and his experience includes license renewal, dry cask storage, and decommissioning. Prior experience includes six years as a Senior Program Manager in the Emergency Preparedness Department of the Institute of Nuclear Power Operations, two years at New York Power Authority, five years at Long Island Lighting Company, and three years at Consolidated Edison Company.
