Cheryl Jenkins is the Emergency Public Information Coordinator for the Perry Nuclear Power Plant, located approximately 35 miles east of Cleveland, Ohio. She has worked in the nuclear industry for 19 years and has been in the Emergency Planning Organization for 15 years. She is currently responsible for maintaining the Emergency Public Information Program to include emergency public information, the Public Information Response Team (PIRT), and the Joint Public Information Center (JPIC).

Previously, Ms. Jenkins was an off-site emergency planner. She was responsible for conducting training and maintaining radiological emergency response plans and procedures for off-site emergency response agencies. Additionally, she has supported plant tour programs, media tours, plant open houses and speakers bureau activities.

She has provided controller support at numerous federally evaluated emergency preparedness exercises at several nuclear power plants, to include: Beaver Valley Nuclear Power Station, Davis Besse Nuclear Power Station, Pilgrim Nuclear Power Station, Indian Point 2 & 3, and the Perry Nuclear Power Plant. Additionally, she has supported self-assessments and conducted benchmarking at several nuclear power plants.

Ms. Jenkins has completed Emergency Planning courses offered by the State of Ohio, the Federal Emergency Management Agency's Emergency Management Institute (EMI) and other organizations. She earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in Communication at Hiram College.
