Dr. John S. Nasstrom is a Program Manager at the National Atmospheric Release Advisory Center (NARAC) at Lawrence Livermore National Laboratory. He received his B.S., M.S. and Ph.D. degrees in Atmospheric Science from the University of California, Davis. He has worked on the NARAC programs since 1984, and made significant contributions in both scientific research and operational support of government agencies with the atmospheric plume modeling and dose assessment tools of NARAC. His areas of scientific research have included boundary layer meteorology and air pollution meteorology, working on the development and application of computer models of atmospheric transport and dispersion of pollutants. He is actively involved in inter-agency federal efforts in emergency preparedness, response and dose assessment.
