### **Nader L. Mamish**

Mr. Nader L. Mamish serves as the Director, Emergency Preparedness Project Office, Office of Nuclear Reactor Regulation, U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC). His office is responsible for developing emergency preparedness policies, regulations, programs, and guidelines for both currently licensed nuclear power plants and potential new nuclear power plants.

Mr. Mamish joined the NRC in 1992 as a Reactor Radiation Specialist in the former NRC Region V. Since that time, Mr. Mamish has held a number of technical and management positions including Senior Enforcement Specialist, Office of Enforcement; Regional Coordinator, Office of the Executive Director for Operations; Chief, Operations Section, Incident Response Operations; and Chief, Coordination Section, Office of Nuclear Security and Incident Response.

Prior to joining the NRC, Mr. Mamish worked at several nuclear power plants in a variety of positions including Supervisor, Health Physics Operations, Florida Power & Light's Turkey Point Nuclear Station; and Supervisor, Dosimetry Laboratory, Yankee Atomic Electric Company.

Mr. Mamish earned a B.S. degree in Health Physics and an M.S. degree in Radiological Sciences and Protection both from the University of Massachusetts.
