Dan Wilcox - Mr. Daniel Wilcox is currently the Deputy Branch Chief for the Radiological Emergency Preparedness (REP) Program within the FEMA National Preparedness Directorate. His 30+ years of Federal service includes over 24 years with FEMA, working in various emergency management disciplines, to include, national security, preparedness, response, mitigation, and, currently, radiological emergency preparedness (REP).

Mr. Wilcox is responsible for overseeing REP program activities, which encompasses 9 FEMA regional offices and all of the nation's commercial nuclear power plants. He provides REP Program guidance and represents the Program Branch at numerous Federal, State and local coordination activities.
